On behalf of the governing body of Beardall Fields Primary and Nursery School I would like to thank you for the positive response to our parent survey. We were overwhelmed with the number of responses as well as the positive feedback. We are always keen to hear what our parents have to say about our school.

It was highlighted in the responses from the survey that a number of parents are unaware of the role the governors play as part of the school and who we are. Hopefully this letter will help to address this.

Our governing body is made up of; 3 parent governors, 5 co-opted governors (which some are parents), 1 local authority governor, 1 staff governor and the head teacher. As a governing body our aim is to ensure pupils are **Happy, Inspired, Valued and Successful**.

To accomplish this we have a strong focus on the three strategic functions of school governance:

1. Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
2. Holding the head teacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils, and the performance management of staff;
3. Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

The full governing body and each of its sub-committees; Strategic Development, Finance and Site & Safety meet once a term. In these meeting we monitor the progress of the school and hold its leaders to account. We are extremely supportive of the school, Miss Collins and the whole staff, its pupils and parents. We wish for Beardall Fields to be the best it can be to allow all of our pupils to be successful.
