

## Nursery Newsletter - Autumn Term

This term our topic is Bears. We will be looking at the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and characters in these books and taking part in activities linked to them. The following topic will be about celebrations.

**Each Friday** we will send home a letter with the phoneme (sound), number and nursery rhyme that we will be focussing on the following week. Please take some time to practise these with your child. On a Thursday for Afternoon Nursery and Friday for Morning Nursery, we will also hand out a library book that can be read with your child. Please return this the following Thursday/Friday so a new one can be given. Home School Diaries will be sent home **every other Friday** with a small activity that can be completed. If you have not already purchased a reading folder these can be purchased from Hucknall Sports and will help to keep your child's belongings safe.

To provide the children with resources needed, such as for baking etc, we ask for a small contribution of **£2 per half term**. Please pass this onto Mrs O'Leary, Miss Collis or Miss Homer.

From **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September** we will be putting out self-registration cards. The cards will have the children's names and photos on for the children to find and stick up before sitting on the carpet. We will then begin to remove the children's photos so they can begin to recognise their name.

As you bring your child, can you please ensure you complete the collection sheet so that we know who will be collecting your child at the end of each session.

When you collect your child at the end of the session, please wait at the gates rather than the door itself, until the door is opened. Some children can become distressed when they can see their adult directly outside the window, so keeping this extra space can help to keep them calm.
