What is the Sports Premium?

The Sports Premium is money which goes directly in to primary schools to be spent on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. This year we received £8995. 7/12s of the money is received in October and 5/12 in April.

| Action | Amount | Impact |
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| To ensure participation both competitive and non-competitive through Ashfield School Sports Network | £700 | Competitive events have been organised after school. A range of sports have been offered to schools. Events have been organised throughout the year and with a special focus on inclusion also. Young ambassador training has led to school events been set up and managed by the children alongside adults. Regular meetings for the PE leader has meant as a school we are kept fully informed of any PE updates. |
| To provide CPD for teachers through Gymnastic coach delivering a series of lessons. | £2,525 | Specialist gym coach delivered gymnastic lessons across school for a half term. Teachers supported in this and developed their own skills in the teaching of gymnastics to their own year groups. |
| To provide CPD for teachers through Dance/Performing Arts teachers delivering a series of lessons | £1400 | Dance teachers to deliver dance lessons from Nursery to Y2, including baby ballet for our very youngest children. Performing arts coaching with dance and drama to support in our KS2 production. Staff CPD through supporting the dance teachers in lessons. KS2 children accessed after school dance club. |
| Mulit-Skills Coaching | £2000 | All KS1 Children accessed Mulit-skills lessons in PE time with class teachers supporting. KS1 children offered Multi- skills after school club. |
| Football coaching | £1025 | Football coaching to support KS2 curriculum and provide after school club for KS2 children in football. |
| Bridging swimming | £273 | SEND swimming extra to curriculum swim – provides specialist swimming support for children with a range of SEND. |
| Transport | £1137 | Transport costs for children to attend competitive and non competitive activities both through School games and football and netball matches |

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| To allow netball team to take part in league | £40 | Girls netball team entered and took part in th3league and tournaments |

Success from the year:

Staff are more confident in teaching more specialist PE areas.

Developed stronger links with outside clubs eg – Basketball. More children attending out of school basketball after coaching in schools, Hucknall Sports FC

Y4 children took part in Change 4 Life Programme between Jan – Mar which the report clearly shows improved fitness levels from the start to end point of the programme

More sports after school clubs were offered last year across the different age ranges– Football, Netball, Dance, Basketball – an increase of 9% on the previous year.

School was awarded the School Games Bronze award with an increase in the number of Level 1 and Level 2 competitions than the previous year.
